## LORD STRATHCONA MEDAL APPLICATION

Ref: CATO 13-16, Annex D

- 1. The Lord Strathcona Trust Fund Medal, most commonly referred to as the Lord Strathcona Medal is the highest award, which can be bestowed upon a cadet in recognition of exemplary performance in physical and military training. Only one such medal may be issued per year per squadron.
- 2. To be eligible for the Lord Strathcona, you must:
  - i. Be a cadet in level three or higher;
  - ii. Attend a minimum of 75 percent of the scheduled training;
  - iii. Meet all requirements of your training level; and,
  - iv. Be regarded by peers and superiors as an exemplary model cadet.
- 3. To apply for the Lord Strathcona Trust Fund Medal, you must write and submit a minimum one (1) page narrative essay describing your involvement with air cadets, your physical fitness routine and why you should be recipient of this award. Applications must be received NLT 13 March 2017.
